SABBATICAL LEAVE GUIDELINES - 2015

1. Short Title, Applicability and Commencement

- 1.1 These Guidelines shall be called the SRGCDS Sabbatical Rules Guidelines-2015
- 1.2 These shall be applicable to all the Academic Staff Members of the Institution.
- 1.3 They shall come into force w.e.f 01st day of April 2015.

2. Right to leave

- 2.1 Sabbatical Leave cannot be claimed as of right and when exigencies so demand, Sabbatical Leave may be refused or revoked by the authority empowered to sanction the leave.
- 2.2 Sabbatical Leave may be granted for one or more of the following objects, namely :
 - 2.2.1 To conduct research or advanced studies in India or abroad.
 - 2.2.2 To write text books, standard works and other literature
 - 2.2.3 To visit or work in a University, Industry or Government research laboratories in India or abroad
 - 2.2.4 Any other purposes for the academic development of the staff member, as approved by the Management.
- 2.3 Academic member concerned shall furnish a letter of acceptance from the host Institution/Laboratory for undertaking advanced study/research.

3. Authority empowered to sanction leave

- 3.1 Applications for Sabbatical Leave shall be addressed to the It should be applied at least three months in advance.
- 3.2 Sabbatical leave shall be sanctioned by the

Commencement and Termination of Leave

4

- 4.1 Sabbatical leave ordinarily begins from the date on which leave as such is actually availed of and ends on the day preceding the one in which duty is resumed. If resumption of duty takes place on the afternoon of a day, leave ends on the same day.
- 4.2 Sundays and other holidays may be prefixed as well as suffixed to sabbatical leave.

5. Combination with different kinds of leave

5.1 Sabbatical Leve cannot be combined with any other leave.

6. Other Provisions f Sabbatical Leave

- 6.1 The Sabbatical leave would be admissible to Academic Staff Members of the Institution who have rendered not less than six years service in the institution.
- 6.2 Sabbatical leave may be granted once in six years, provided, the academic member concerned has not gone on one year or longer deputation or assignment or study leave during the preceding six years.
- 6.3 Sabbatical leave will accrue 60 days per completed year of service (for part of the year, it may be on proportionate basis) and can be accumulated up to a maximum of 12 months. After total accumulation of 12 months of sabbatical leave, no carryover of sabbatical leave(part or full) will be permissible over and above 12 months accumulation. During the probation period, there will be no accrual of sabbatical leave.
- 6.4 Sabbatical leave may be granted for a period of not less than four months and not more than twelve months inclusive of vacation at a time.
- 6.5 On availing the sabbatical leave and/or after rejoining the duty, if any academic member resigns within two years, he/she shall refund the salary paid to him/her during the period of his/her sabbatical leave. The requirement of serving the institution for a minimum period of two years after availing sabbatical leave may be reduced to one year in cases where the staff member is unable to serve the institution for a period of two years on the expiry of the sabbatical leave due to superannuation.
- 6.6 For all purposes the period of sabbatical leave shall be treated as a period spent on duty without entitlement to TA/DA. In case the academic member proceeds abroad, the institution will have no financial obligations except mentioned in this guidelines including medical expenses.
- 6.7 On completion of sabbatical leave, the academic member shall submit a detailed report on the work done and objectives accomplished.

- Staff members shall be paid full salary during the period of sabbatical leave under the normal rules as would have been otherwise admissible to him/her. However, payment of DA, HRA and CCA etc., during the period is subject to Government of India rules in this regard. But, he/she shall not be entitled to any travelling allowance or any extra allowance in India or abroad.
- On sabbatical leave, the academic member staying in the campus could carry 6.9 on with his/her academic work, but he/she cannot hold any administrative/financial position/responsibility in the Institution or of any other body/committee constituted by the institution.
- The applicant concerned shall give an undertaking before proceeding on 6.10 sabbatical leave that he/she will utilize it for bonafide purpose for which it is sanctioned and will not accept any commercial employment during the period
- An employee on sabbatical leave cannot take up a position elsewhere, which is 6.11 either tenured or leads to a tenured position. He/she shall, however, be free to receive a scholarship or fellowship or bursary or any other adhoc honorarium other than regular employment.
- Normally between two occasions of availing sabbatical leave, there should be 6.12 a minimum gap of one year of regular service (in case earlier leave not taken for full year, the remaining leave may be taken after a gap of one year only). Sabbatical leave will not accrue during the time it is availed.
- At any point of time, a maximum of 10% of the sanctioned strength of the 6.13 academic staff members of the institution(subject to any fraction in the figure thus arrived at being rounded off to the next higher integer) may be permitted to avail of long leave either within India or abroad. No substitute shall be appointed in the vacancy and the work shall be shared by the other members of the faculty.
- During the period of sabbatical leave the applicant may continue to retain 6.14 accommodation in the institution campus on the same terms and conditions as are applicable to other employees of the institution. If the applicant during the period of leave resides in India, he will be entitled for medical support as per the rules of the institution.

One of the main objectives of the University is to promote research activities in the University and also affiliated colleges. In this regard University had invited applications for financial assistance for conducting of advanced research projects for the year 2015-16. University had received 366 research proposals. The University had earmarked Rs.5.00 crores in its budget estimate for the year 2015-16 for this purpose. In order to meet this expenditure the concerned Subject Experts as suggested by the concerned BOS PG chairpersons and the Expert Committee comprising of all the BOS PG chairpersons have scrutinized the proposals and shortlisted them based on the criteria set out by the University. Such of the proposals which have fulfilled the norms have been recommended by the Expert Committee for sanction of grants.

The Syndicate in its 116th meeting held on 16th December 2015 has approved to sanction the grant-in-aid as per the recommendations of Expert Committee for 159 selected proposals in medical, dental, pharmacy, ayurveda, nursing, physiotherapy, allied health sciences and BNYS faculties for the year 2015-16.

Pursuant to the approval of the Syndicate, sanction is hereby accorded for release of grant-in-aid amounting to Rs. 3,50,000-00 (Rupees Three lakhs fifty thousand only) towards research proposal "Evaluation of Serum Hepcidin in Oral

- The Principal / Head of Institution shall open a separate joint account for the financial grant released by RGUHS in the name of Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator.
- 2. Principal / Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator shall be responsible for the accounts and the proper utilization of the funds. The grants released shall be used only for research purpose.
- 3. 50% of the grant-in-aid approved by RGUHS shall be released as 1st installment. 25% of the grant-in-aid shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 1st installment is given. Balance of 15% shall be released after the Utilization Certificate for the money released in the 2nd installment is given. Remaining 10% will be released after the submission of Project Report to the University. Audit report shall be submitted along with every Utilization Certificate.

- 4. The project shall be completed within 2 years from the time of release of 1st installment of grant-in-aid. However, the University in deserving cases may extend this time frame.
- 5. Principal Investigator shall furnish project status report once in six months till the completion of the project.
- During the research work, officials of the Expert Committee along with Subject Experts shall reserve the right of inspection.

- 7. All the details about the conduct of research activity along with documents should be properly maintained by the Principal Investigator. He/She should submit such details of research to monitoring committee or to the University whenever it is called for.
- 8. ICMR and MCI guidelines especially with regard to ethical issues shall be followed strictly in the research activity.
- Regarding ethical issues in various faculties, the guidelines prescribed in the apex bodies or any other related authorities regarding the conduct of study should strictly be adhered to.
- 10.Research project shall be published in national/international indexed journals after the completion of the project. During such publication it is the duty of the Principal Investigator to acknowledge the assistance given by the University as a source of funding for the research activity.
- 11. In case the Principal Investigator discontinues the research work under unforeseen circumstances, the co-investigator shall continue the research work and complete the project with the approval of the University. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution to ensure, in such circumstances, that the research is completed with the co-investigator of the research project.
- 12. It is the responsibility of the Principal/Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator to ensure that research work is completed within the stipulated time.
- 13. The grants released by the University shall not be utilized for the purpose of purchase of equipments.
- 14. The honorarium for the supportive staff, purchase of consumables, tests carried outside the institution because of lack of infrastructural facilities in the institution, travel grants for attending conference for presenting the research work and for publication of papers in national / indexed journals shall be met out of the grant-in-aid.
- 15. After the completion of the project the entire project report shall be submitted to the University and will become property of the University.
- 16.If any of the conditions mentioned above are not adhered to by the Principal/ Head of the Institution and the Principal Investigator, University reserves the right to take appropriate action.
- 17.In research proposals involving clinical trials, if any untoward incidence occurs, it is the responsibility of the Principal Investigator and the

Institution to deal with the same and the University will not take any responsibility in this regard. The Principal Investigator is advised to enter into insurance schemes to meet any such adverse eventuality as per the decision of the IEC.

Further the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator has to submit a joint affidavit duly signed by both of the Principal / Head of the Institution and Principal Investigator which has to be notarized mentioning all the conditions from Sl.No.1 to 17 and stating that they will be abide by the conditions stipulated in this order.

Only after the receipt of Pre-receipt certificate and the affidavit as above, further process for release of research grant-in-aid will be initiated. These documents have to be submitted to the Director, Advanced Research, RGUHS (superscribing the documents as ("Advanced Research proposal") either in person or by post on or before 18th January 2016 without fail. Soft copies of these documents shall also be sent to <u>rguhsresearch@gmail.com</u> before 18th January 2016.

Cheque has to be collected **in person** at Advanced Research Wing of RGUHS after the intimation from the University and no representatives are allowed to collect the cheque.
